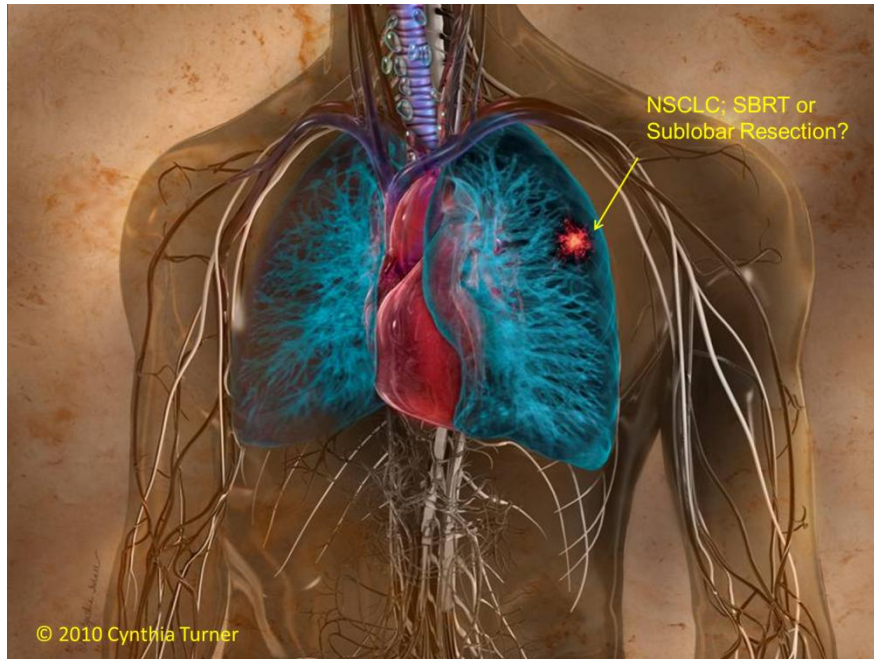


Dear Z4099/R1021 Investigators,
